Result: The improved tools significantly reduced harvesting time by about 40-50%, physical drudgery about 50-60% and hand injuries, skin irritation by around 70-80% compared to manual hand picking.

Result: Available nitrogen and potassium remained at lower or near-constant levels after harvest due to higher crop uptake associated with improved growth and yield, while available phosphorus showed slight improvement, possibly due to enhanced phosphorus availability under balanced nutrition. The application of sulphur and zinc improved root activity, enzyme functioning and overall nutrient uptake efficiency, which resulted in significant improvement in agronomic parameters and crop performance. Thus, the observed yield enhancement was primarily due to improved nutrient utilization rather than accumulation of nutrients in the soil. Although post-harvest soil test values of sulphur and zinc remained almost unchanged, their application enhanced nutrient uptake efficiency through several physiological and rhizospheric mechanisms. Sulphur improved nitrogen assimilation by promoting protein synthesis and enzyme activity, while zinc played a key role in auxin synthesis, enzyme activation and membrane integrity. The combined application of sulphur and zinc resulted in better root growth and a more active rhizosphere, which enhanced absorption of native soil nutrients, particularly nitrogen and potassium. Consequently, improved nutrient utilization strengthened the source-sink relationship, leading to superior agronomic performance and higher grain yield of paddy.
